## **CALL FOR PROPOSALS**

### **Scholarships for foreign undergraduate students**

The Foundation for the University of Sopron awards scholarships based on a call for proposals to support the studies of foreign students pursuing bachelor's degree program studies at the University of Sopron within the framework of the Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship program and who undertake to continue their studies in a master's degree program at the University of Sopron and declare their intention for admittance to this program.

**Who can apply:**

The scholarship is open to undergraduate students receiving a Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship and can be applied to every semester, starting from the third semester of studies.

**The amount of aid:**

The scholarship is HUF 40,000 per person per month (five-month financing period, every six months).

**Conditions for a valid application:**

- active student status in full-time undergraduate studies;
- a minimum 4.0 weighted grade point average in the last active semester before the semester applied for;
- have completed a minimum of 55 credits in the two semesters before applying for the scholarship;
- other specific conditions set by the relevant faculty and laid down in the call for proposals;
- pursuing an academic or outstanding artistic or sporting activity;
- a declaration of intent to pursue a master's degree at the University of Sopron.
- outstanding student community service will be an advantage in the application evaluation.

The proposal must be submitted in the Neptun system (application code: SOE\_12\_03)

Proposal submission deadline: **27 October, 2024 (24:00)**

Annexes to be attached to the application:

- supporting documents for scientific or outstanding artistic or sporting activity
- a declaration of intent to pursue a master's degree
- certificate of outstanding student community service (optional)

Annexes can only be attached to the proposal in **PDF** format.

Failure to meet the deadline will result in a penalty; the evaluation committee will not consider late or incomplete applications.

The bodies involved in the evaluation of the application:

- Committee for the Development of Education (opinion)
- University of Sopron Foundation Board of Trustees (final)

**More information:**

The Board concerned will evaluate the scholarship applications by 15 November, 2024. The applicant will receive the decision via the Neptun system. For further application information, please send an e-mail to [soea-osztondij@uni-sopron.hu](mailto:soea-osztondij@uni-sopron.hu).

The maximum number of students expected to be awarded a scholarship is 20 per institution.

Student status terminations or suspensions will sever scholarship fund disbursement. The student must repay the scholarship disbursed before the student status termination or suspension.
